These general multi-disciplinary databases provide access to articles in newspapers, magazines, trade publications, and scholarly journals. For articles on plagiarism in a particular field or subject area, look for databases that cover that area.

Academic Search Premier	Multi-disciplinary database, many articles are full text.
Research Library	Multidisciplinary collection of journal articles on a variety of subjects, including animal rights.
Omnifile Full Text Mega	Multi-disciplinary database, including full text general science coverage.
