Strike to focus attention on Vietnam war

At a rally behind Wilson Hall at 12:00 Wednesday, Bob White, S.G.A. pres., spoke to aprox. 200 students about bringing the Vietnam war back to front page news.

White said that a student strike was the best way he knew of to focus attention on the war.

He stressed peaceful civil disobedience for the Monmouth strike of May 5, 6, and 7.

Another rally at 3:00 in front of the Edison Science Building was then announced by White. This rally, to take place simultaneously with the faculty vote on the Weinberg case, was to urge the faculty not to penalize striking students.

White also voiced the need for new student leaders to carry on the anti-war movement next year, and asked for new people to help the present leaders make this strike more effective.
