

# A View from the Right

Let's be honest as a nation and stop hiding behind Wilsonian idealism. Why are we fighting in Viet Nam? We are there to guarantee the sovereignty of Viet Nam. But why do we want to guarantee this sovereignty? Are we great altruists who want the Vietnamese to be free? Do we want to export American Democracy? Did we invade the Dominican Republic to preserve freedom? There was never any freedom in Santo Domingo to preserve. So why did we interfere?

The answer to the preceding two questions is simple, self preservation. We owe an apology to no one. International Communism in all of its apparent forms has one thing in common. It holds the conquest of the world as its ultimate international goal. When Mr. Khrushchev said that Communism will bury us, he meant it! Both China (RED), and the Soviet Union has declared war on the Western Democracies and the United States in particular.

We will take Eastern Europe, infiltrate Western Europe, take the masses of Asia and Africa, and encircle the United States of America, which will be the last bastion of Capitalism, and it will fall into our hands like an over ripe fruit without a shot being fired. I contend that the Communists have been carrying out this blueprint with little deviation.

All of Eastern Europe is in the Communist Bloc. The Communist Party in Western Europe gains more influence with each passing day.
