

# Peace center urges don't pay taxes

The U.S. government is using our money to kill our Vietnamese brothers and sisters, while GIs die there and people die in our cities. \$608 million dollars from N.J. residents was used last year for the war. We want this money to provide services for the people: decent schools, adequate health care, mass transit instead of more highways and

war materials.

REFUSE \$10 to \$50 of your income tax; instead send it to the People's Life Fund of N.J. c/o the Capital Peace Center, 124 North Montgomery Street, Trenton, N.J., 08608--it will then be channeled to groups who will use it to serve N.J. people--N.J. WRO, etc., or send it directly to a group you know working in your area to help people, not kill them.

REFUSE to pay the 10% surcharge tax on your telephone bill--it was added to pay for the Vietnam War-- tell the phone company that you will pay for service, but not for murder.

AND START PAYING FOR SERVICES IN OUR COMMUNITY. SERVICES YOU PAID FOR--BETTER SCHOOLS, BETTER TRANSIT, MORE HOUSING, ADEQUATE MEDICAL CARE FOR ALL. . . . THE STATE LEGISLATURE WON'T MAKE THESE THINGS HAPPEN UNLESS THEY ARE PUSHED--THE PEOPLE MUST PUSH THEM.
