

U.S. Out of Indochina

Despite claims that the VietNam war is winding down, Nixon has in fact escalated the war. He has increased the bombing, blockaded the harbors of North VietNam and is carrying on an assault against the Vietnamese dike systems. Also claiming that the Vietnamese have not been negotiating seriously in Paris, Nixon has persistently ignored the peaceful settlement put forward by the Vietnamese

people over a year ago. This reasonable proposal provides for a peaceful settlement of the war, release of all POW's and a democratically elected government in the south.

Nixon's lies have been exposed in many ways by veterans returning from Viet Nam and denouncing the war and by U.S. civilians touring Viet Nam. Jane Fonda and Paul Mayer have just concluded such a tour.
